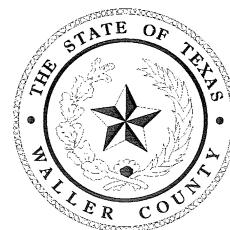

Re: Permit Requirements within Unincorporated Areas of Waller County

To Whom It May Concern:

Addressing

A 911 address must be issued prior to issuance of any permits within the County. Contact Johnny Boyd, 911 Coordinator, for additional information. See our website at www.co.waller.tx.us/othercountyoffices/engineer and click on the Docs/Forms link.

Permits

The permit requirements within Waller County are the following:

1. **Development Permit** – for new construction (including earthwork) in the 100-year floodplain. Contact Yancy Scott, Asst. County Engineer – Engineering Dept., for a floodplain determination or more information. The regulations and forms are available on our website.

Development means any man-made change to improved or unimproved real estate including, but not limited to, buildings or other structures, mining, dredging, filling, grading, paving, excavation or drilling operations or storage of equipment or materials.

2. **Driveway/Culvert Permit** – for access to existing County roads. Contact Yancy Scott for more information. The regulations and applications are available on our website.
3. **OSSF Permit** – for installation of a private septic system. Contact Winford Roberts, Designated Rep. – Environmental Dept., for more information. Visit our website for the appropriate regulations and applications.
4. **Certificate of Compliance** – for rental communities upon approval of the Infrastructure Development Plan. No utility services can be provided prior to the issuance of this certificate.

Issuance of an official 911 address is required before any of the above permits will be granted for construction.

Building Codes

There is no building code promulgated by Waller County for the construction of single/multifamily residential, commercial, or public buildings at this time.
